Opportunities to work with us



You may have heard about the proposed Australia Pacific LNG Project which will span from gas fields in the Surat and Bowen Basins in Queensland along a 450km pipeline to a proposed LNG facility near Laird Point on Curtis Island off Gladstone.

The Australia Pacific LNG project is a joint venture owned 50:50 by Origin and ConocoPhillips to deliver a coal seam gas (CSG) to liquefied natural gas (LNG) project in Queensland.

Australia Pacific LNG is working towards making a final investment decision by the end of 2010. This decision will follow an extensive approval process by State and Federal Governments and will lead to an investment of billions of dollars of capital into the project, delivering benefits and opportunities for Queensland for at least the next 30 years.

With scale, comes opportunity

The size and complexity of the Project lends itself to generating significant benefits for local regions throughout the Project development area.

A new long-term gas processing and export industry in Queensland will be created. During the peak construction phase an estimated 5,000 direct jobs will be created with a further 1,000 long-term jobs resulting during the operational phase. Purchasing goods and services and hiring locally, wherever viable, will increase expenditure in regional economies.

Opportunities will be provided for suppliers, contractors and employees alike across all regions of the Project development area.

Three main project components to choose from

There are three main components to the Project where supplier, contractor and employment opportunities may become available:

1. Further development of Australia Pacific LNG's existing **coal seam gas fields** in the Surat and Bowen Basins.
2. Construction of a **gas transmission pipeline** which will be approximately 450km long from the coal seam gas fields to an LNG facility at Curtis Island, off the coast of Gladstone.
3. **Development of the LNG facility** (including gas processing, liquefaction and marine infrastructure) which will have a capacity of up to 18 million tonnes per annum of LNG.

A variety of employment opportunities will be available

The gas fields and pipeline components of the Australia Pacific LNG Project will generate a peak workforce of approximately 3,000 workers during the development and construction phase and approximately 1,000 during the operational phase.

The LNG facility component of the Australia Pacific LNG Project will generate a peak workforce of approximately 2,100 workers during the construction phase. A workforce of approximately 100 is estimated to be required to operate the first LNG train at the LNG facility, with approximately 75 further people required for each additional train. Further people will be needed during major maintenance activities.

So, workers across a range of occupations including professionals, technicians, trades, managers, clerical and administrative roles will be needed.
