

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1994 - Section 152
Application Notice - Australia Pacific LNG Project

Resource activity: Site specific petroleum activity

It is advised that Australia Pacific LNG Pty Limited has lodged an application to amend environmental authority (EA) EPPG00787513 in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The application relates to Petroleum Leases (PLs) 43, 44, 45, and 218 located approximately 50 km north-west of Injune covering an area of approximately 60,000 ha in the Maranoa Regional Council area.

The proposed resource activity includes alignment of monitoring conditions with other Australia Pacific LNG EAs and adoption of streamlined model conditions for stimulation activities.
